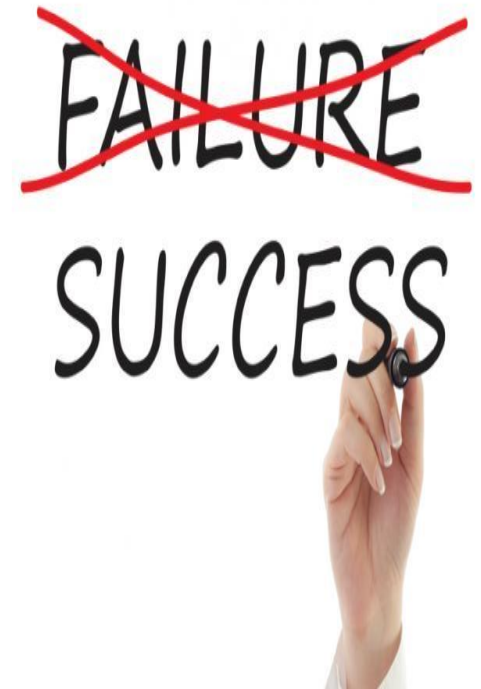

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What is the purpose of the Student Success Center?

The Student Success Center is designed to provide an alternative structured learning environment, for students who are unable to receive success in the traditional classroom or school setting.

The Student Success Center will assist students in obtaining academic success in the following areas:

- Improving self- concepts and attendance
- Improving self -awareness of consequences of one's actions
- Developing respect for authority
- Developing skills for conflict resolution
- Developing the ability to accept responsibility
- Developing an awareness of career options

The Student Success Center has three programs designed to familiarize students, with a range of strategies to manage behaviors, in order to be successful in the Macon County Public Schools:

- Student Success Center's Long -Term Placement Program
- Student Success Center's Second Chance Program
- Student Success Center's Choices for Success Twilight Program

The Student Success Center's *Long - Term Placement* is designed to serve as an alternative to out-of-school suspension. Students are referred based on disciplinary infractions. This program serves students from grades 7-12 through outside agencies and classroom activities.



Second Chance

The *Student Success Center's Second Chance* Program is designed to serve as an intervention to reduce dismissal from school, for the lack of sufficient progress. This program will provide an alternative setting for students enrolled at Booker T. Washington and Notasulga High Schools who are deficient in one or more of the following areas:

- Behind two or more academic years
- Pregnancy/other health conditions
- Chronic absenteeism
